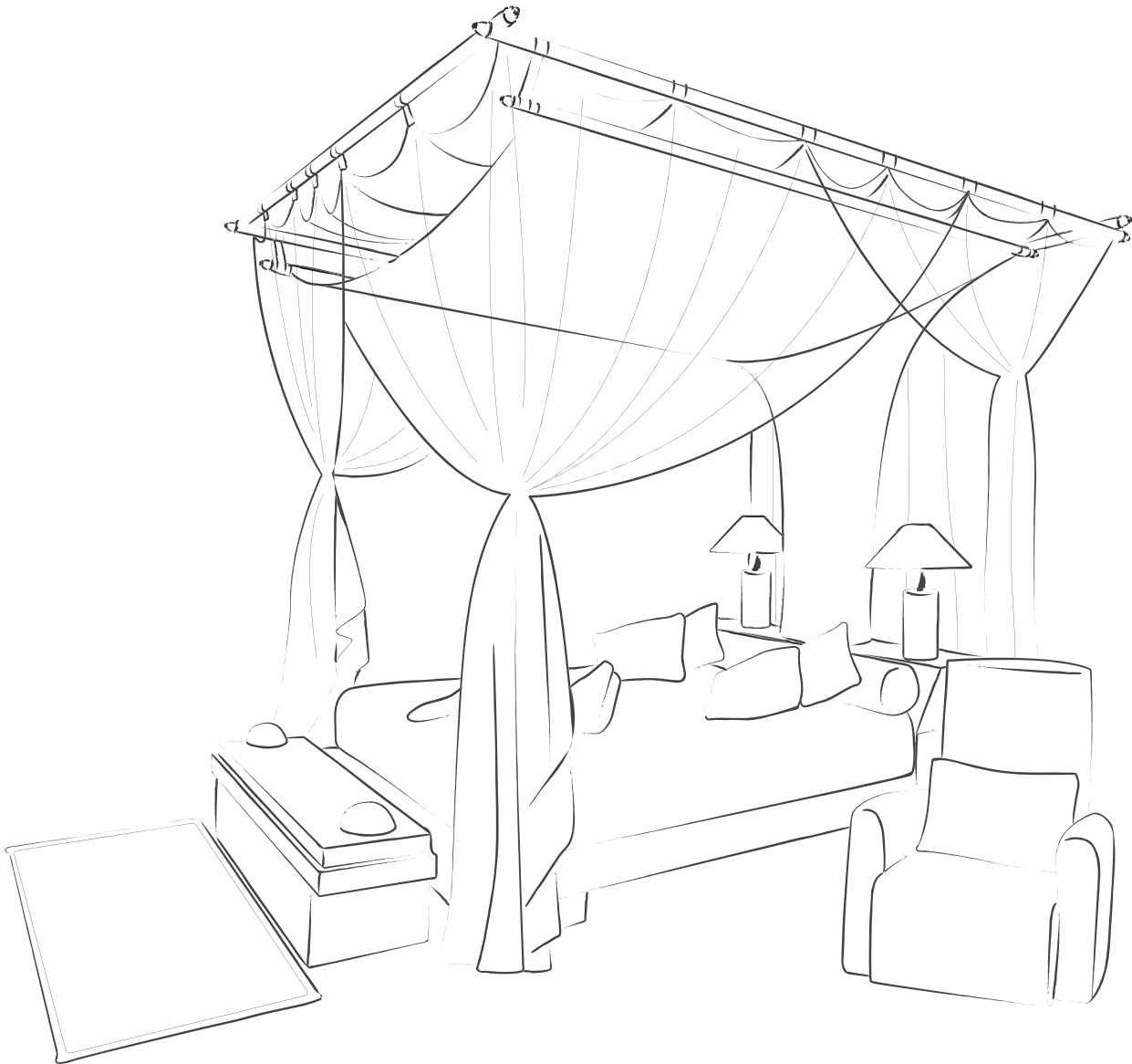


A two beam wooden frame is suspended from the mosquito net frame to accommodate the Evening Breeze textile ventilation system. The textile can be slightly draped to fit the look and feel of the current setup.

The Evening Breeze cooling system can be integrated in the headboard given the headboard has a depth of 30cm or more.

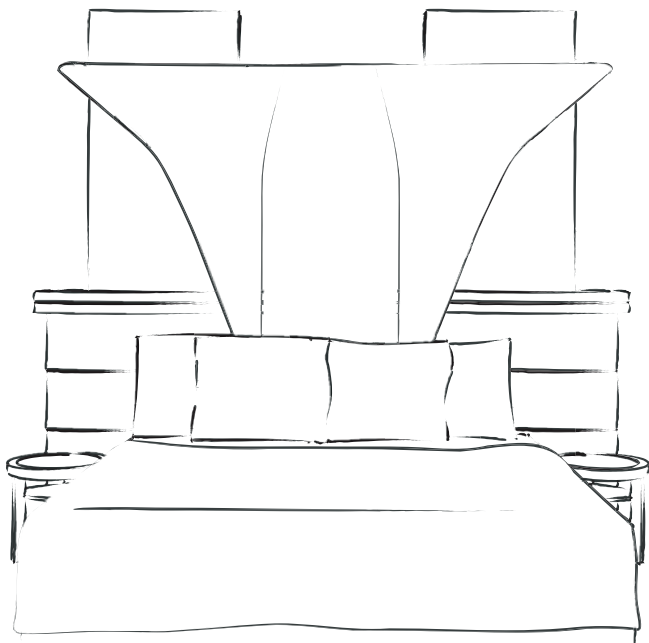
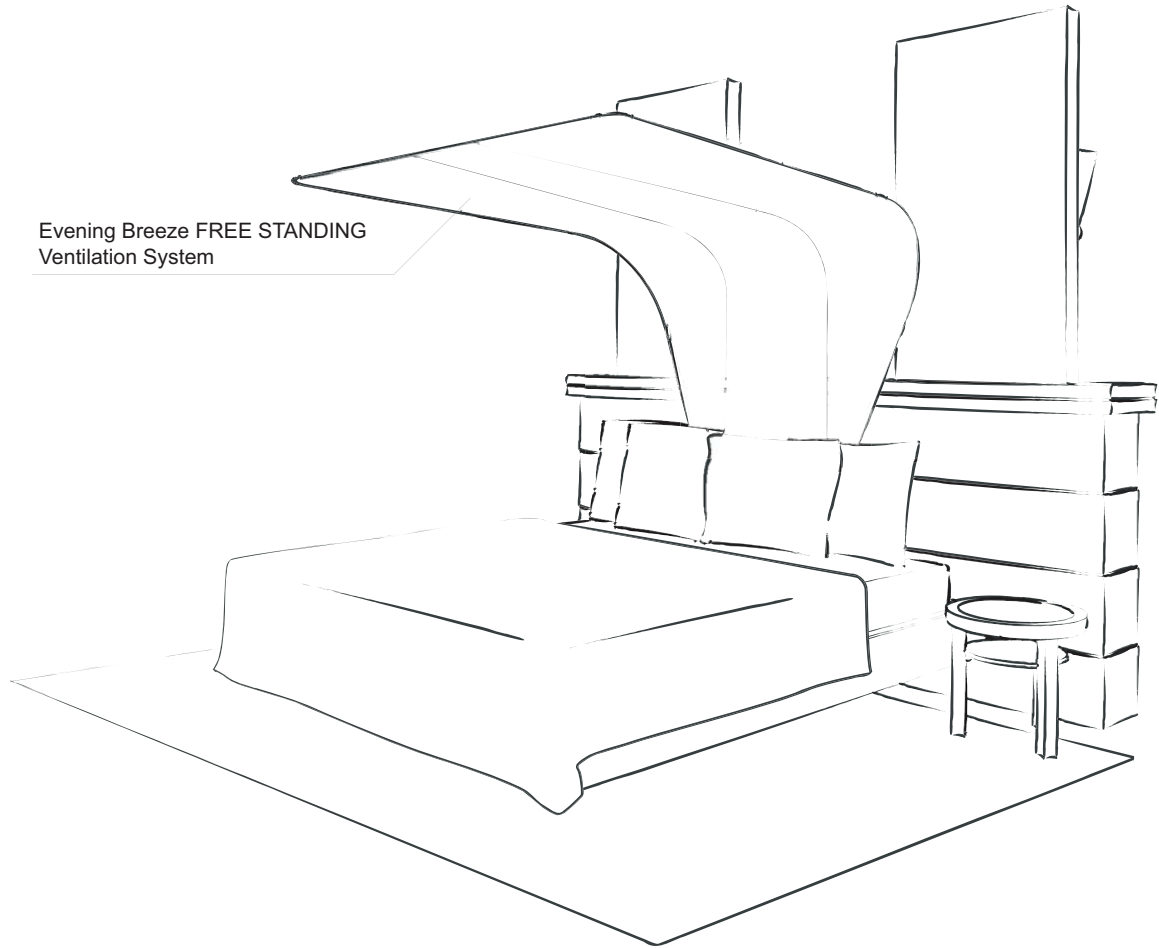

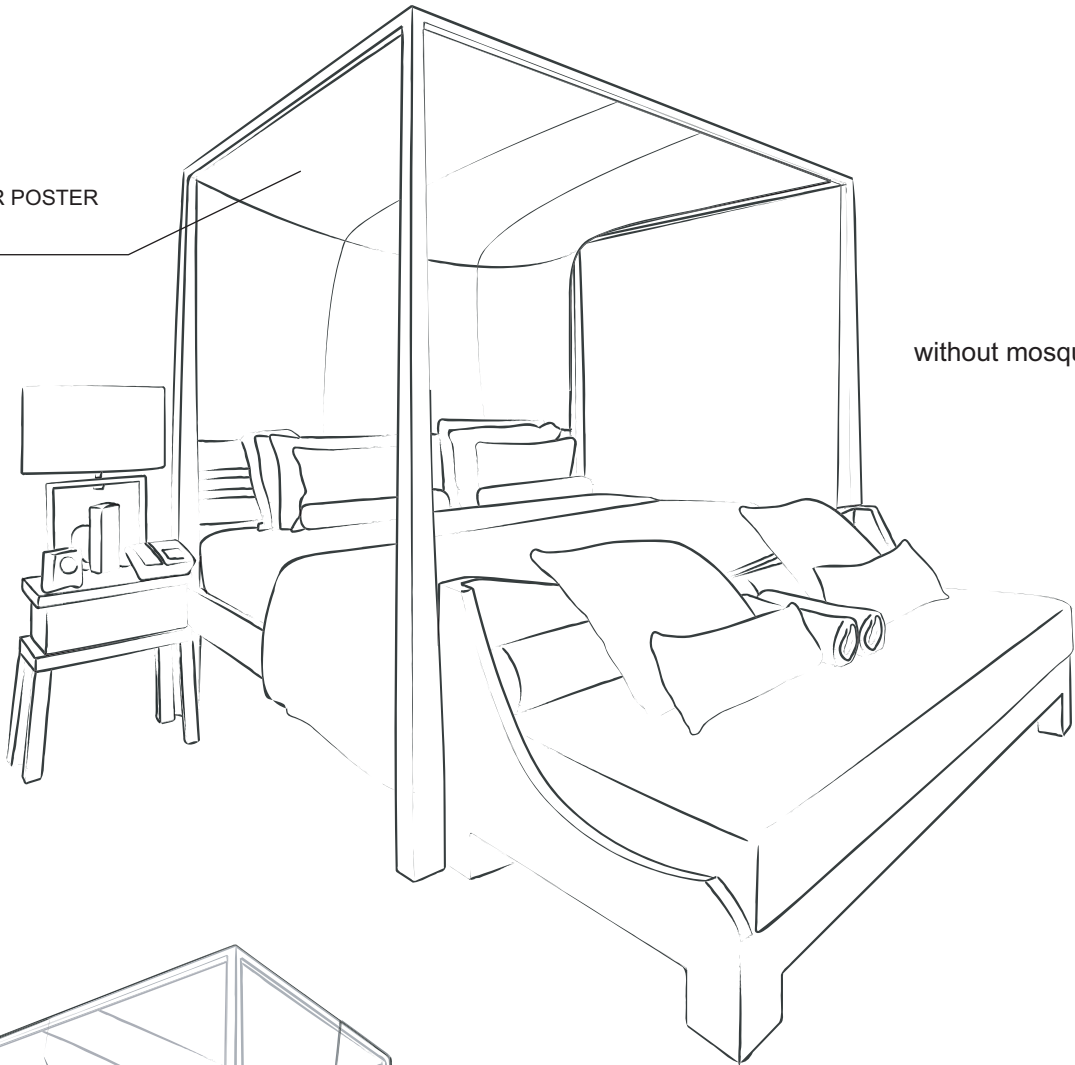


Evening Breeze FREE STANDING
Ventilation System

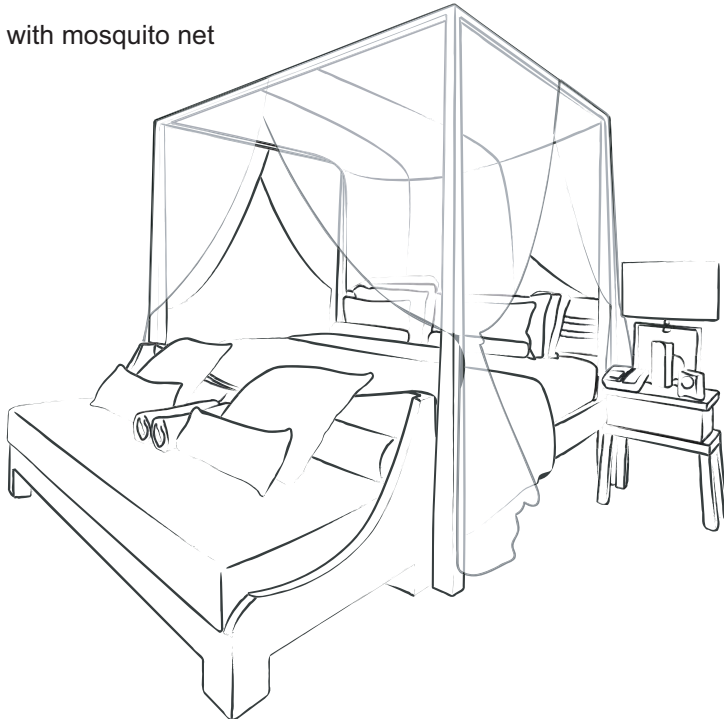


Evening Breeze FOUR POSTER
Ventilation System

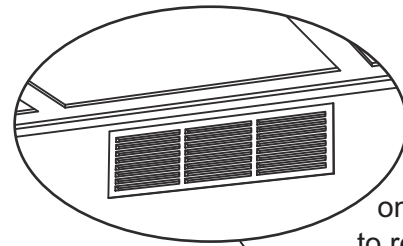
without mosquito net



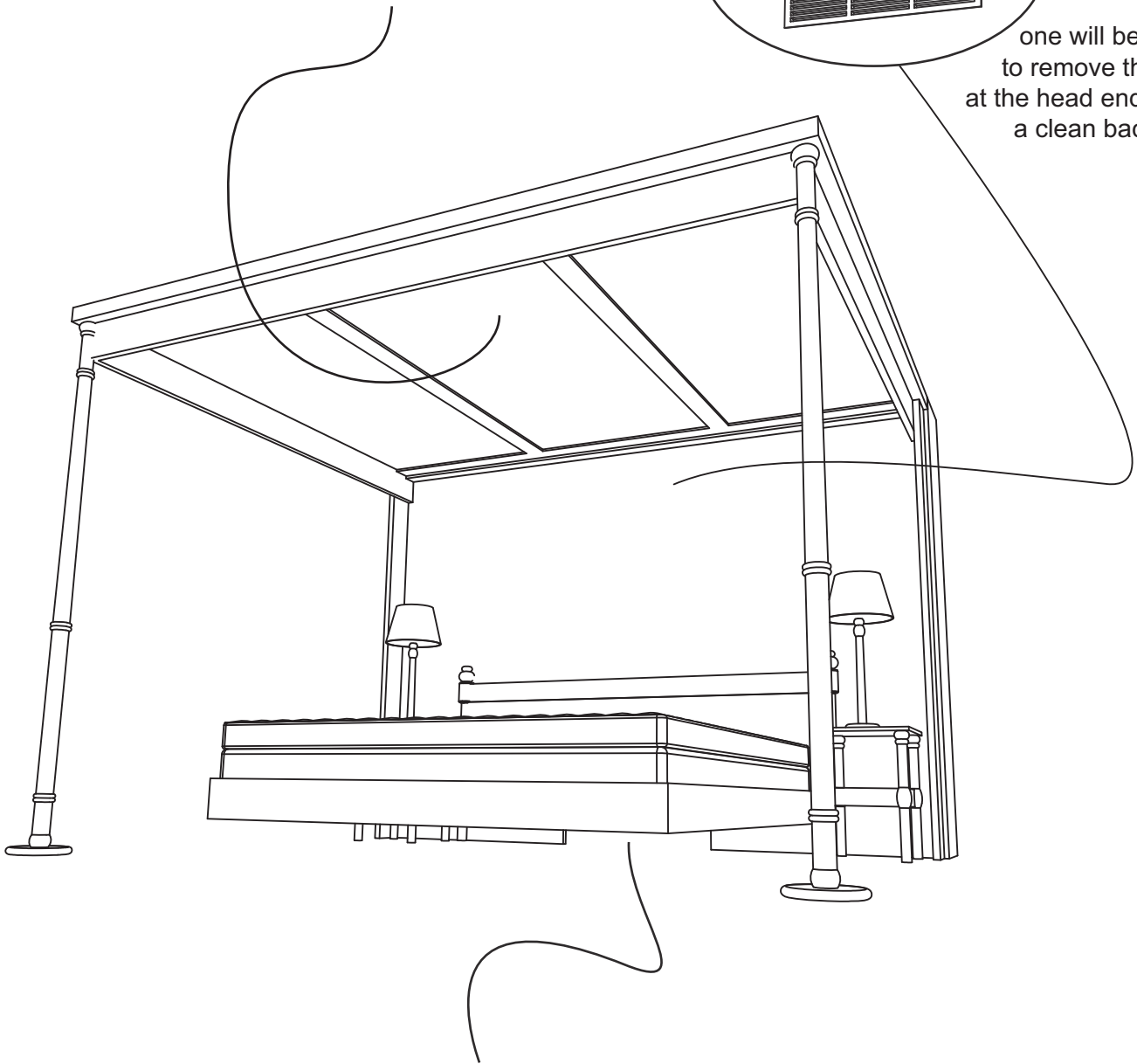
with mosquito net



the centre ceiling panel will be replaced by the Evening Breeze textile ventilation system to gently spread the conditioned air over the sleepers



one will be able to remove the vent at the head end to create a clean back wall



a 800 x 200 mm hole in the wall underneath the bed will enable the Evening Breeze system to recycle some of the cooled air, creating a highly efficient cooling cycle

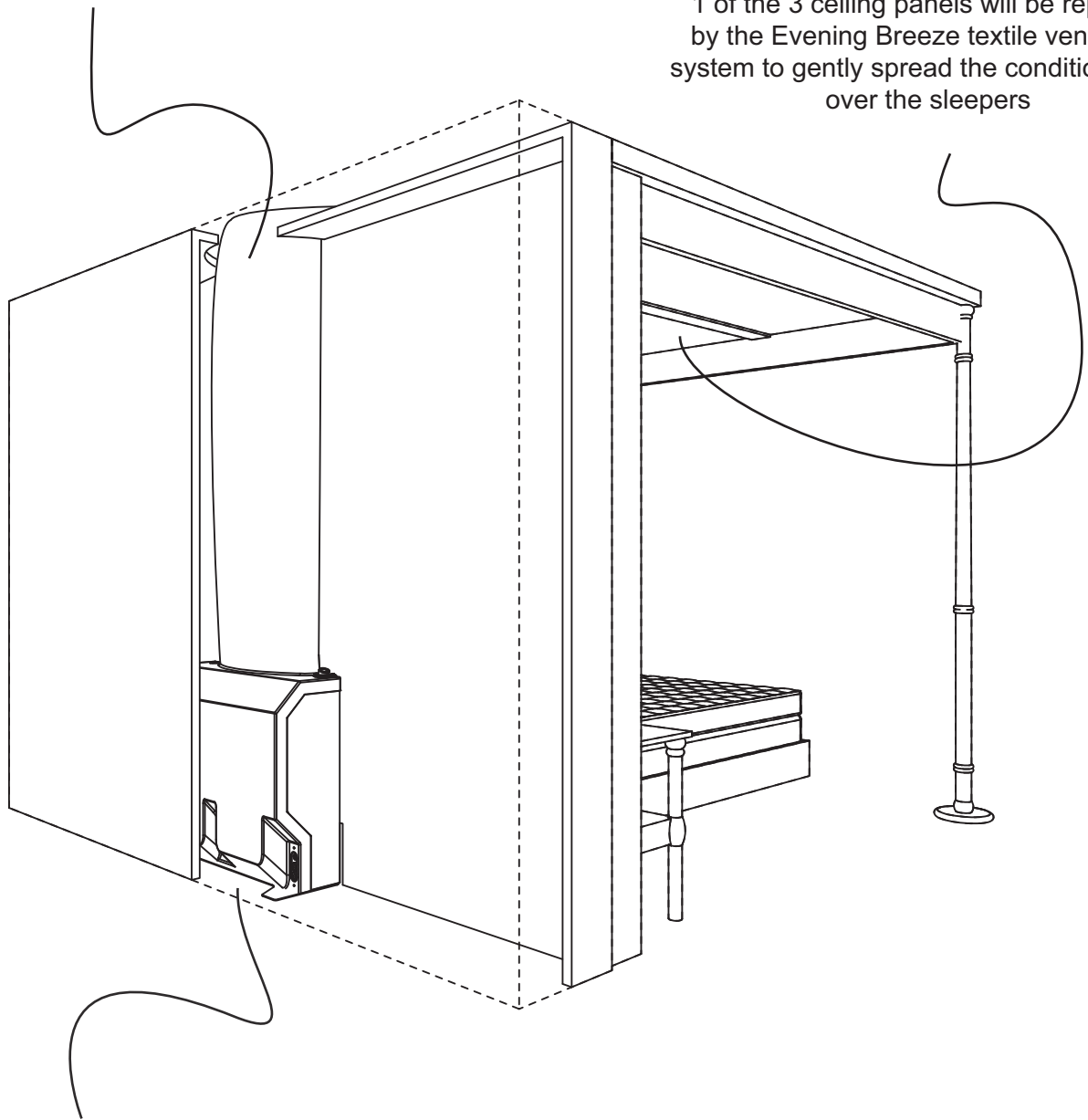

of the bed

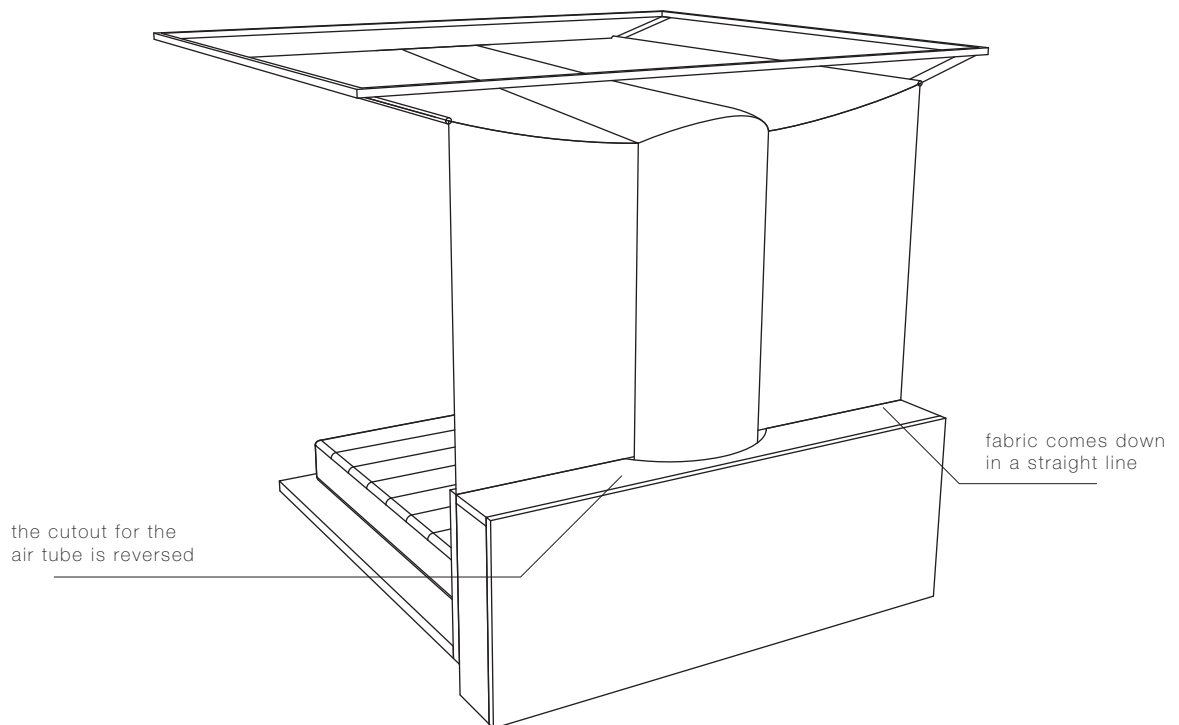
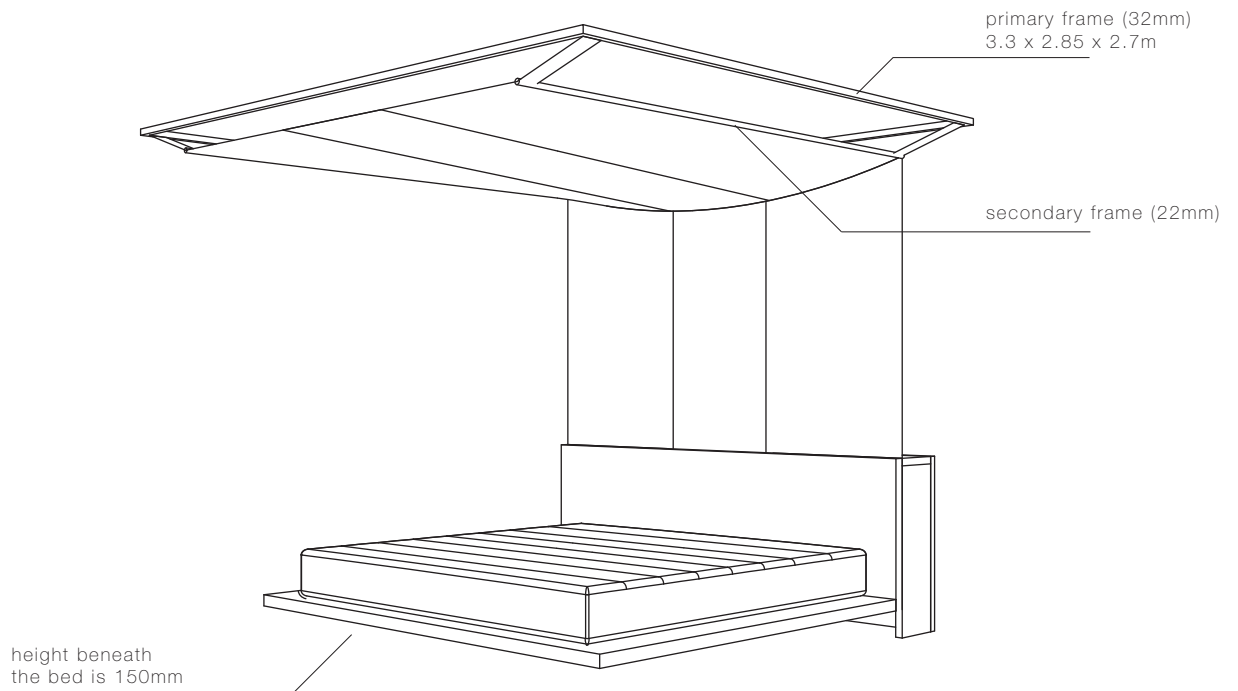

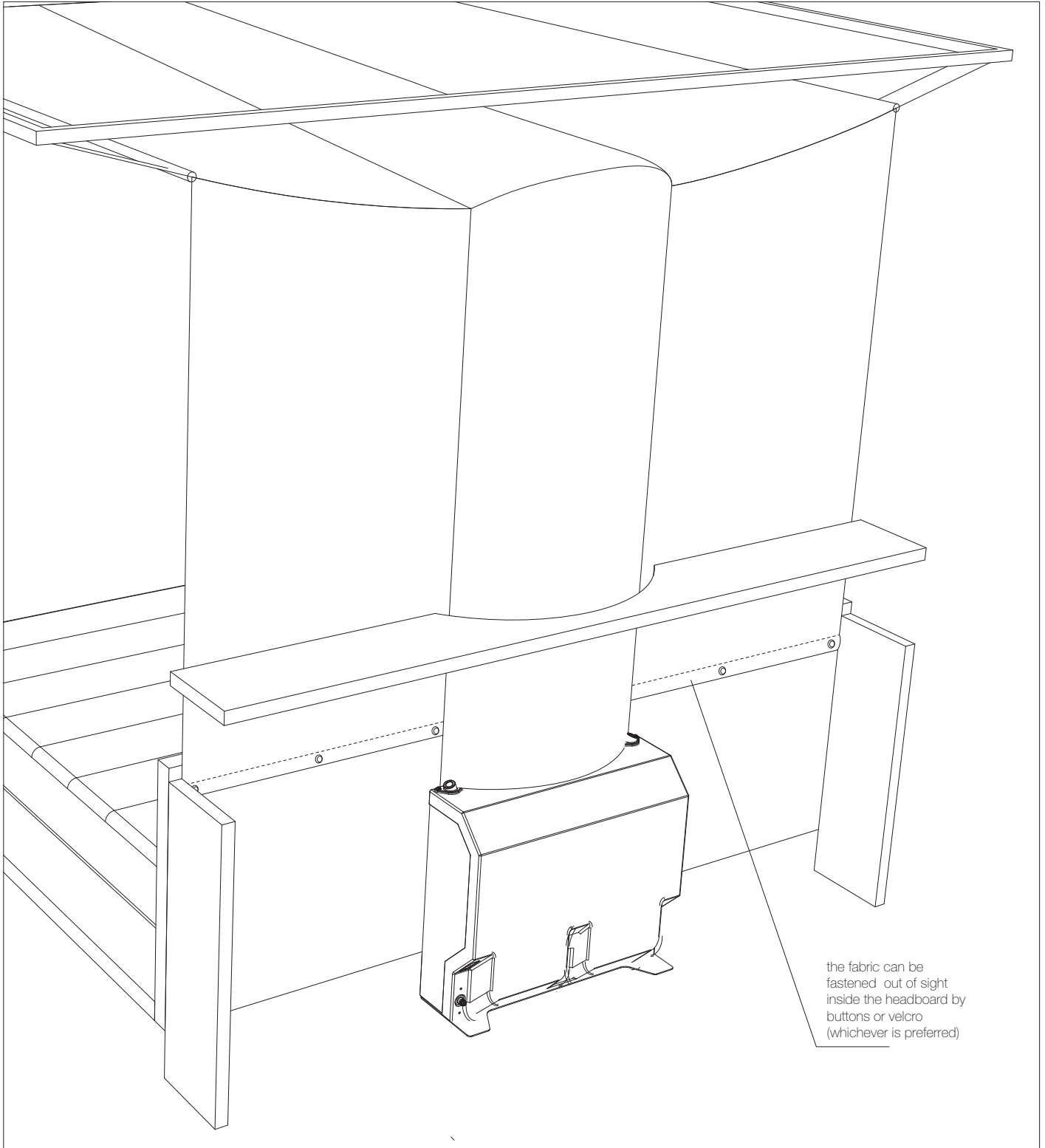




notes: This is the setup of the bed excluding the mosquito net provided by Kiwinet.

the mosquito net which is suspended on the primary frame shown here.

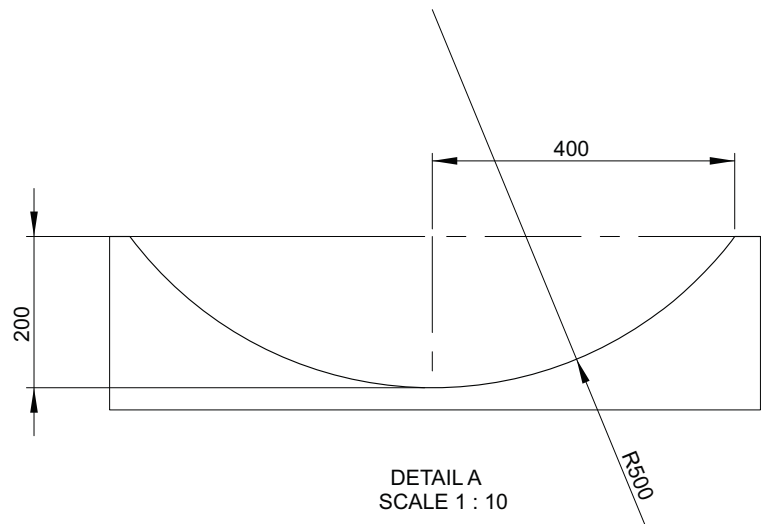
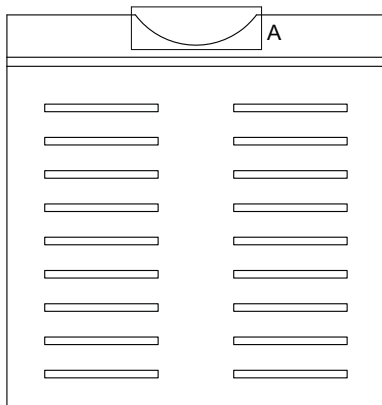
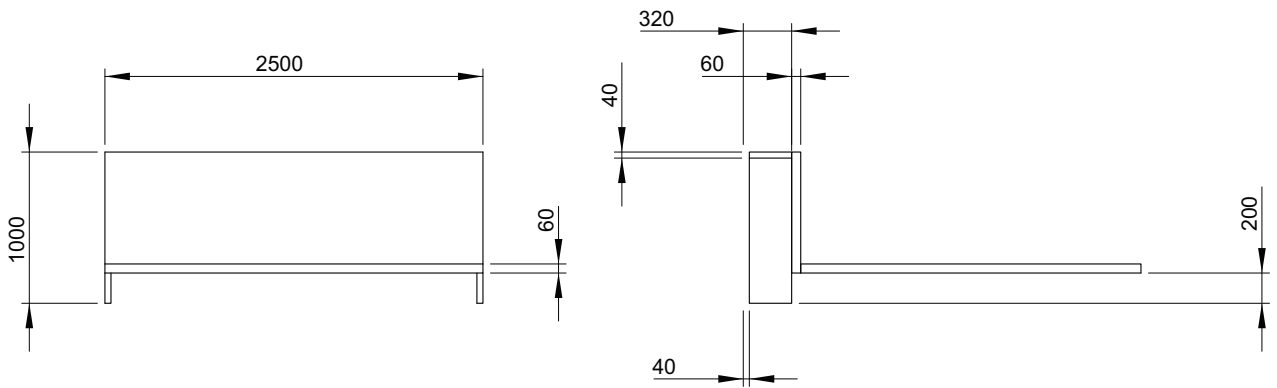
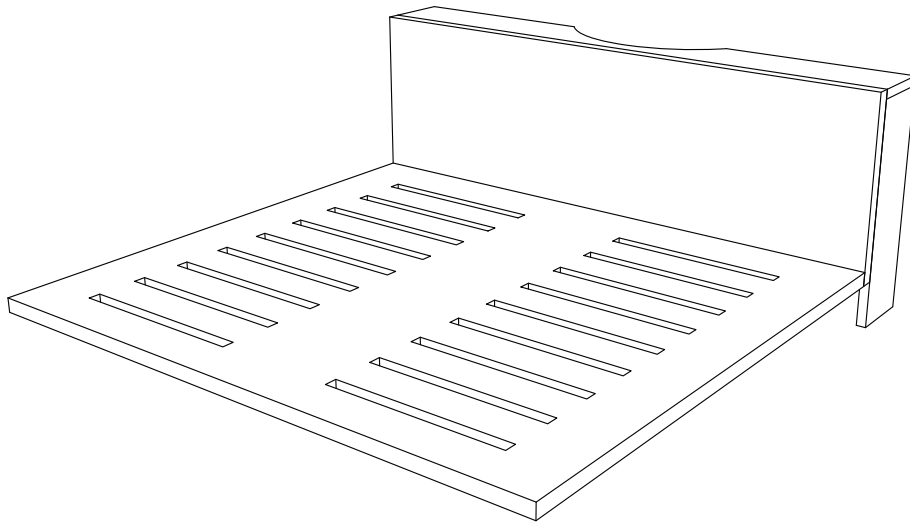

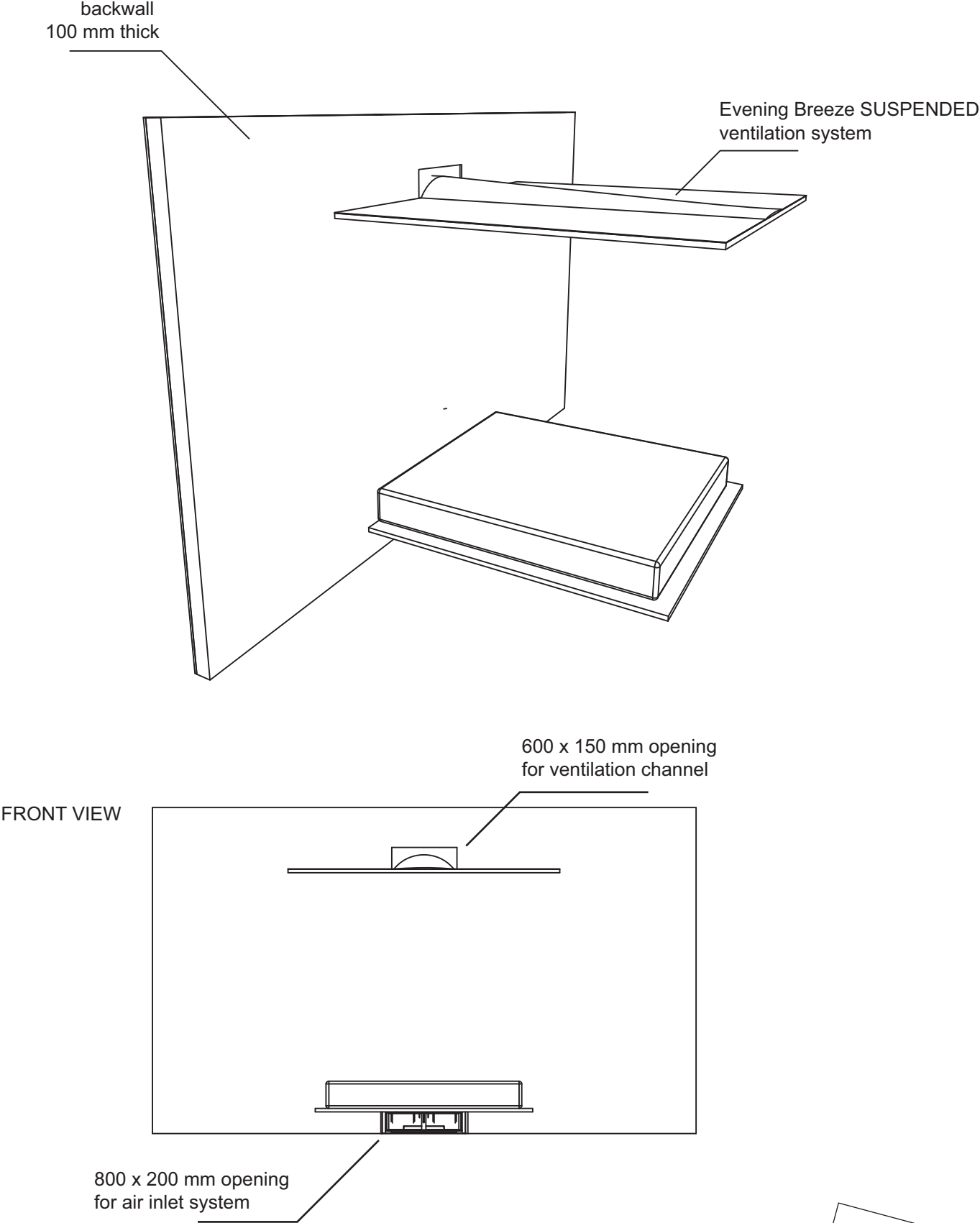
MOSQUITO NET HANGING

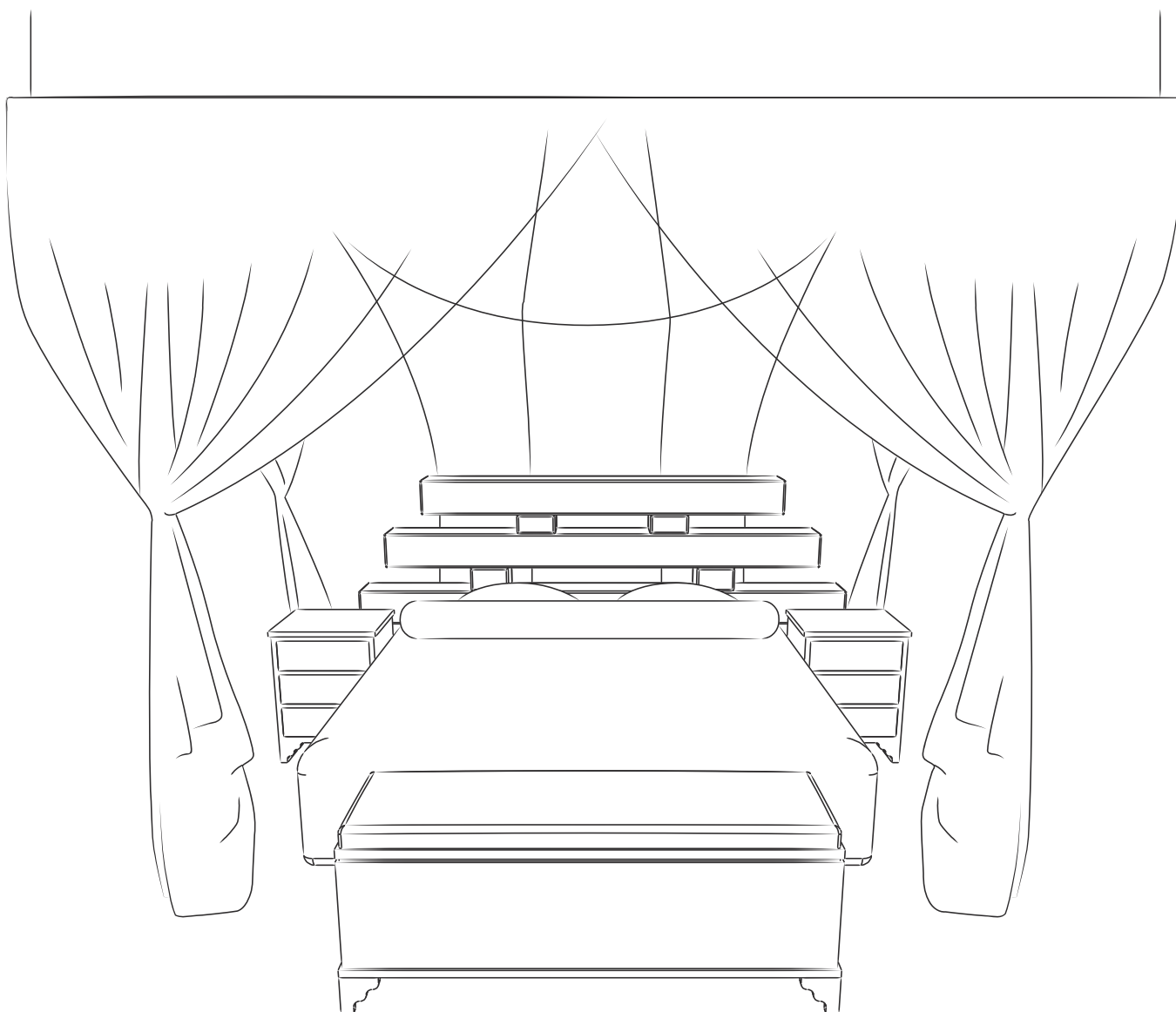
Evening Breeze ORIGINAL - 3D view (with mosquito net)

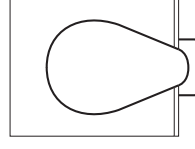




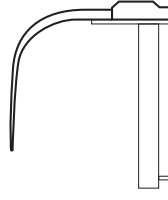
